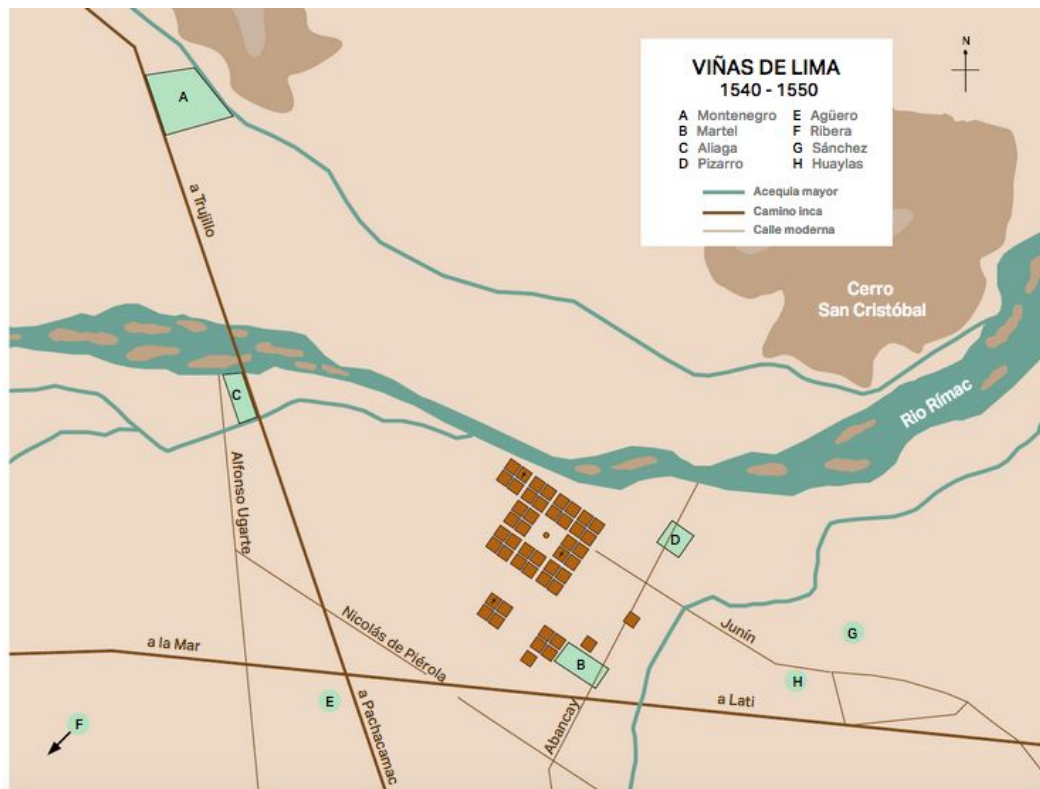

1539-1541

First vine planted in Peru

1551

The first wine was made in Lima

1595

Philip II began to heavily tax vineyards in Peru & prohibited planting vines in the colonies

16th Century

Peruvian wine production & exportation reached their peak

1614

Peruvian wine prohibited in Guatemala and Panama

1641

King Philip IV prohibited the importation of Peruvian wine to Spain
